Job Requirements:

- Degree or above in Counselling or Social Work, Master's degree in Counselling Psychology preferred
- 2-3 years relevant working experience preferred
- Skilled in case and group works, case management and counselling
- English (Syllabus B in HKCEE) and Chinese at Grade E in HKCEE/Level 2 (Pass) in HKDSE
- Fluency in English and Cantonese

Job Duties:

- To develop and implement suicide preventive programmes for the Elderly through “Mental Well-Being Nurture Groups” including activities, training, counselling, treatments and other interventions for the groups for the elderly.
- To train Youth Ambassadors to support elderly in suicide prevention, by equipping them with practical knowledge in providing emotional support, and constructive ways to cope with emotional difficulties
- To develop and implement internal training programmes and activities in suicide prevention for potential volunteers and retraining sessions to existing volunteers
- To develop and implement outreach and educational programmes, activities and training in suicide prevention
- To promote service and recruit partnering agencies and liaise, collaborate and coordinate with volunteers and external partners
- To develop content, coordinate production and broadcasting of a short promotion video set on suicide prevention, and assist in other publicity initiatives
- Follow-up with working reports and handle service accounts.
- Other relevant duties assigned by the Chief Operating Officer
